The meals you provide and deliver will go to local families in need who sign up through Lansing Christian Services.

Sign-up online at rivchurch.com/thanksgiving. After you sign-up you will be assigned a name of a family that you will be delivering to. Please contact them within 24 hours to let them know that you will be providing them a Thanksgiving meal and to find out if they have any special requests or dietary restrictions. You will then arrange a time that works for both of you to deliver the groceries.

ALL DELIVERIES SHOULD BE MADE NO LATER THAN SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 22.

Your shopping list should include but is not limited to:

- one turkey
- one pie
- one stuffing mix
- potatoes
- rolls and butter
- a vegetable
- a fruit
- a beverage (non-alcoholic, please)
- whatever else they ask for or you want to give

Please be firm about establishing boundaries if the family assigned to you asks for extra things that are more than you are comfortable giving. If a family asks for assistance for Christmas, you can refer them to the Salvation Army.

Any cash donations that Riverview receives beyond what we need for the Thanksgiving drive will go into our general Compassion fund.

VENUE DROP-OFF

If we have any donations beyond what we need they will go to the City Rescue Mission.

After you sign-up you will purchase and bring ALL the items on this list to the Compassion table in the lobby during each service at the Holt, REO Town, or Westside Venues the weekend of November 22. *You won't need to deliver the meal directly to the family.*

THANKSGIVING DROP OFF CHECKLIST:

(NO ADDITIONAL ITEMS, PLEASE)

- One check for \$26 made payable to Riverview Church (write "Turkey" in the memo line)
- One apple or pumpkin pie (pre-made, no refrigeration needed)
- A dozen dinner rolls (pre-made, no refrigeration needed)
- One 5 pound bag of potatoes
- One 1 pound bag of stuffing
- Two 10.5 ounce cans of turkey gravy
- Two 14 ounce cans of cranberry sauce
- One 29 ounce can of sweet potatoes
- One 16 ounce bag of marshmallows
- One 11.5 ounce canister of ground coffee
- Two 14 ounce cans of green beans
- Two 14 ounce cans of sweet corn
- A disposable turkey roasting pan
- A box of sandwich-size Ziplock bags
- A roll of plastic wrap
- A roll of aluminum foil
