Quick Thoughts

Through 1 Corinthians 6:12-20 we see that the only lasting driving force for fleeing sexual immorality is our identity in Christ. Specifically, this text shows us that through the Gospel we are not our own, but instead members with Christ, one with God, and a temple for the Holy Spirit. The reason that it is important for us to have our identity be the driving force to flee sexual immorality rather than rules or shame is that this is the only means that true change happens from the inside out.
